Neatly copy the ten menu words and add the English translation.

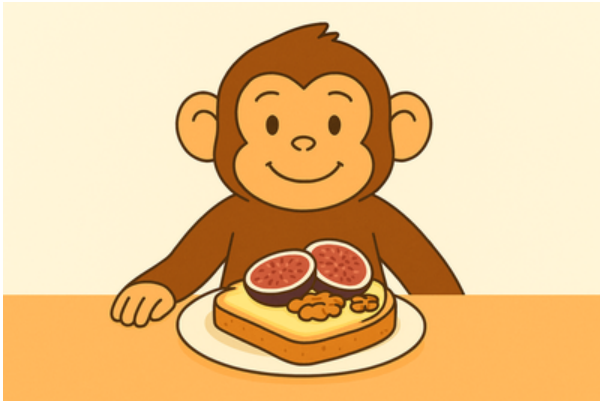
Ermanno's Homework

Sometimes we add mozzarella or ham, but the heart and soul of bruschetta is bread, tomatoes, garlic, olive oil and basil.
